SAROJINI NAIDU

- Sarojini Naidu was born in 13 February 1879. She was born in Hyderabad.

SAROJINI NAIDU

- She was a political activist, feminist, poet, and the first Indian woman to be president of the Indian National Congress and to be appointed an Indian state governor. A proponent of civil rights, women's emancipation, and anti-imperialistic ideas, she was an important figure in India's struggle for independence from colonial rule.



THE NIGHTINGALE

- Sarojini Naidu was nicknamed THE NIGHTINGALE. This title was given by Mahatma Gandhi, the Nightingale of India, meant BHARAT KOKILA. She was given this title on account of the beautiful and rhythmic words of her poems that could be sung as well.



THE FIGHTER

- She was one of the brave and fearless **FREEDOM FIGHTER** . She had joined this movement in the wake of partition of Bengal in 1905
